Programme to progress and CCG has reinforced that we are keen to be considered as a pilot site.</p> <p>Update 04 Feb 20: LA is meeting with Nick Hill from transforming systems this week. LA spoke to their CEO who said that EMIS and System one have declined access to their systems to run the project as it stands and they are negotiating a way forward.</p> <p>Update 20 Feb 20: Status update to be reported at February meeting.</p> <p>Update 27 Feb 20: Liz Angier met with Nick Hill from transforming systems. Noted that trying to take forward the work with reduced functionality with a table of indicators. Feasibility of taking this forward is being explored with a Winchester Practice as a pilot site. Concern was expressed around the block to accessing systems by companies and it was questioned if this has been discussed/escalated at a senior level.
